John Bushrot is described in his Will as a husbandman from Sherborne in Dorset. A husbandman is a person who cultivates crops and breeds and raises livestock. This description is appropriate as his Will contains bequests for 8 acres of various crops, 36 sheep, and a young cow.

Under the terms of the Will his wife Margery received the use of the estate for three years and thereafter received the residue of the estate. If she remarried within the three-year period, then the overseers of the estate were directed to shift the benefit of the assets described in the specific bequests for the children from Margery to the children.

The Will contained the following bequests for their children:

John received 8 acres of crops, a wagon, a featherbed which originally belonged to John Bushrot's father (no name is provided), ten sheep, various household items, including a silver spoon, and his father's clothing, except for his best coat, which he had to wait for three years before he could wear. Richard received £5, ten sheep, and a silver spoon.

Robert received £5, ten sheep, and a silver spoon.

• Margery received £6, 13 shillings, and 4 pence, but no sheep or silver spoon.

The son, John, was to receive his bequest three years after his father's death, perhaps because he would soon be 21 years old. The younger children had to wait three years to receive the benefit of their bequests, and they would not get full possession until the earlier of getting married or becoming 21 years old. If any child died before taking possession of their bequest, then the bequest would be divided equally among the remaining children.

The will also contains a bequest of two sheep for a god son "John Waye", two sheep for "Charles Wiffin", two young sheep for "Luce Dowle", three shillings and four pence for "John Yetman", and two shillings for the parish church of Sherbourne.

"At Bushfield, Wet'd Co., the tomb of John Bushrod bore this inscription: 'Herelies the body of John Bushrod, gentleman, son of Richard Bushrod, gentleman, by Apphia his wife. He was born in Gloucester Co., Va., the 30th of Jan'y, 1663.He took for his wife Hannah, the daughter of William Keene of Northumberland, and Elizabeth his wife, and by her he left two sons and four daughters, and died the 6th of Feb'y, 1719, in the 56th year of his age.' (M., II., 151.)" (Virginia Genealogies, p 636, On-Line Genealogy Library database)

The appearance of the name "Washington" in the list of persons buried at Bushfield provides a tantalizing clue to some interesting family connections. Hannah Bushrod was not the only child of John Bushrod (1663-1719) and Hannah Keene (1676-1739). They also had a son named Col. John Bushrod (1712-1760), whose third wife was Mildred Corbin (1720-1785). Their daughter was named Hannah Bushrod (1738-1804). She was the niece of the Hannah Bushrod who married Adam Crump. On April 14, 1756, she married John Augustine Washington (January 13, 1735/1736-January 8, 1787), the brother of President George Washington (February 22, 1732-December 14, 1799). Prior to that, this Hannah Bushrod was mistress at Mount Vernon during George Washington's bachelorhood. Hannah inherited Bushfield in 1760 upon the death of her father, Col. John Bushrod. All of Hannah and John Augustine Washington children were born at Bushfield. They had a son, Bushrod Washington (June 5, 1762 – November 26, 1829), who fought in the American Revolution and was a member of the Virginia House of Delegates. He was also a member of the Virginia convention that in 1788 adopted the Constitution. On February 4, 1799, he became an associate justice of the U.S. Supreme Court. In 1801, he inherited Bushfield upon the death of his mother. He sold it in 1804 and moved to Mount Vernon, which he inherited after Martha Washington's death. He was one of the executors of George Washington's estate, and he also received the following specific bequest:

To my nephew Bushrod Washington, I give and bequeath all the Papers in my possession which relate to my Civil and Military Administration of the affairs of this Country; I leave to him also such of my private papers as are worth preserving; and at the decease of my wife, and before; if she is not inclined to retain them, I give and bequeath my Library of books, and pamphlets of every kind.

Hannah and John Augustine Washington had two daughters, Jenny Corbin Washington (d. 1791) and Mildred Washington. Jenny Washington, who was called Jane, married William Augustine Washington, the son of her father's half brother Augustine Washington. The youngest child of Hannah and John Augustine Washington was Corbin Washington (1764-December 10, 1799). Corbin married Hannah Lee (1765–November 23, 1801) on May 10, 1787 at Bushfield. She was the daughter of Richard Henry Lee, a signer of the Declaration of Independence. Corbin Washington had lived for many years at Walnut Farm, originally a part of the Bushfield farm in Westmoreland County, but by October of 1799, he was living at a home called Selby in Fairfax County (WAYLAND [1], 125). The following entry was recorded for November 5, 1799 in George Washington's diary (Diaries, 6:374): 5th. Morning and the whole day calm--clear & pleasant. Set out on a trip to Difficult-run to view some Land I had there & some belonging to Mr. Jno. Gill who had offered it to me in discharge of Rent which he was owing me. Dined at Mr. Nicholas Fitzhughs and lodged at Mr. Corbin Washingtons

Oddly, Corbin died a month later on December 10th and George died four days later. There is no mention of Corbin's death in Washington's diary, and he may have been unaware that Corbin had passed. Corbin was listed as an executor for and a beneficiary of George Washington's estate, however, his death four days prior to George made these provisions moot.

(Note: George and Martha Washington had no children, thus his property passed to his nephews and nieces and their descendants).

John Bushrod and Hannah Keene also had a daughter named Elizabeth Bushrod, who married William Meriwether. His father, Nicholas Meriwether II, was the great great grandfather of Meriwether Lewis, the Lewis of the Lewis and Clark Expedition.

John Bushrod and Hannah Keene had another daughter named Apphia (who was named after her grandmother, Apphia Hughes, who married William Fauntleroy.

"Richard Doggett was the second surviving son of the Rev. Benjamin Doggett andhis wife Jane, and the first of their children born in Virginia.

He is believed to have been born about 1672. As the parish register of Christ Church Parish in Lancaster county has been lost, no documentary evidence of his birth date exists. However, Rev. Benjamin, in his will refers to his '2 sons born in Virginia,' and his birth does not appear in the register of Hadleigh parish in Suffolk, so we are sure that he was born after his mother came to Virginia to join herhusband. Richard is named in his father's will as devisee of one hundred acresof land, being a part of the 350 acre plantation owned by his father. . . The will further provided that Richard, his brother William, and his sister Anne should live with their older brother Benjamin until they could live on their own, and there is some evidence in court records that Richard was in fact cared for by Benjamin. In February 1687/8, when Richard was about 15 years of age, Benjamin brought a lawsuit in Lancaster County Court against John Boatman, who married Jane Doggett after Rev. Benjamin's death, complaining that Boatman had brokena contract with Richard to pay him one-half of the crops produced by Richard laboring in the fields on Boatman's plantation, for the purpose of providing clothing for Richard's use. The court found that Boatman did in fact owe Richard ashare of the corn and tobacco harvested, and ordered that it be delivered by Boatman to Benjamin so that clothing could be provided for Richard." Mount Vernon, March 13th, 1858

To A "Southern Matron"

Madam

Your letter of March 12th has been received in which you inform me that the bill providing for the purchase of Mount Vernon by Virginia, has been defeated in the House of Delegates— and in the name and on behalf of the Mount Vernon Association you renew your offer to purchase this place.

Heretofore I have only been willing to dispose of Mount Vernon to the United States or to Virginia as I believed that in the hands of one or the other it would be better protected and preserved than in the possession of any individual or association. The events of the past seven years however, seem to indicate that neither Virginia nor the United States wish to acquire the place.

Under the circumstances, and believing that after the two highest powers in our country the Women of the land will probably be the safest as they will certainly be the purest guardians of a national shrine, I am willing so far to comply with your request as to await for a

seasonably limited period of time the propositions

you may wish to make to me on behalf of the Association over which you preside. And I assure you that unless these proposals are inconsistent with what I believe to be my duties upon the occasion

I shall be inclined to give them the most favorable consideration. With assurances of the highest respect

I have the honor to be your obdt. servt.

In 1859 Gatewood hadan argument with a San Andreas physician, Dr. Peterson Goodwyn over Col. E. D.Baker, a spellbinding abolitionist orator who had appeared in the town. Goodwyn called Gatewood a liar, Gatewood knocked him down, Goodwyn challenged Gatewood to a duel. There is every indication Gatewood tried to get out of it, but thedoctor's demands were too much even for Mary Gatewood. She bought a bullet and gave it to her husband to show she was with him in the fight. At 40 paces, with a rifle, Gatewood shot and fatally wounded Goodwyn. The attorney was with TheUnion only from its founding in the fall of 1868 to the spring of 1869. He sold his interest to Charles P. Taggart then. . . As a lawyer he handled most of the criminal work here for many years. . . He was city attorney from 1874 to 1876, resigning because of ill health.
